

## 4x4 Driver Recommended Equipment List

The following is an example of the type of equipment that may need to be carried but not limited to within the 4x4 vehicle depending upon the severity of the environment that the vehicle may be driving in.

### Example Equipment List:

#### RECOMMENDED OFF-ROAD VEHICLE EQUIPMENT LIST

- 1 x toolkit
- 1 x spare parts box
- 1 x first aid kit
- 1 box of smoke canisters
- 1 vhf radio
- 1 gsm telephone
- 1 gps system
- 1 x compass
- 1 x map
- 1 hand held search light
- 2 x 20 litre water containers
- 2 x 20 litre fuel containers
- 2 x fire extinguishers
- 2 x spare wheels
- 2 pair gloves (heavy duty leather)
- 1 length of hessian shelter (to attach to side of vehicle)
- 1 dozen hessian sacks (sand bags)
- 2 x shovels
- 1 set aluminium sand ladders
- 1 set jump leads
- 1 set spare keys (lightly oiled and placed in tin with magnet stored on the vehicle)
- Front and rear tow bars
- 1 x air compressor
- Webbing tow straps
- Tow ropes (steel hawser type or specifically designed kinetic tow ropes)
- Balloon jack
- High lift jack
- Electric drum type winch (casual type) and anchor plate
- Snatch block pulley and rope
- Heavy duty steel draw bar (used in pairs as an a frame for towing)
- Towing shackles (military specification jate rings part no rrc3237)
